Discussed the SFA 4v4

SFA Assistant Coach/Tournament Coordinator Trae Manny collected paperwork and went over details and updated the board on what to expect for the SFA 4V4 Tournament scheduled for 4/25/09.

Holly will serve as registrar for the Tournament

Sam reports Ref Assignor must be US Soccer Certified – Greg reports no problems w/ this.

Refs need to be US soccer certified as well

Sam requests NYSA stop killing the grass when lining the fields – all agreed

Sam suggested the tournament be U10, U12, U14 – board disagrees and wants U8 included.
